



Transfer Admission Agreement FAQ & Instructions

What is A Transfer Admission Agreement?

A Transfer Admission Agreement guarantees, in advance, admission to The University of the Pacific.

A Transfer Admission Agreement (TAA) is a formal, written agreement that outlines the courses you must complete and grade point average you must earn before transferring from a community college to Pacific. You should fill out this form at least six months before you plan to attend.

After the TAA is written, it must be signed by you, your counselor and a Pacific representative. These signatures guarantee that you will be admitted to the University of the Pacific in the major specified, for the specified term, provided you complete the terms of the agreement.

With the assistance of your JC/ CC counselor, fill out the Guaranteed TAA form by February 1st to enroll in the next Fall term or by July 1st to enroll in the next Spring term you plan to attend and mail it to the Office of Admission.

Students may file their TAA in two methods:

Plan A

- They must complete Thirty (30) semester units or Forty-Five (45) quarter units, including specific courses for certain majors, before the end of the term prior to attending. Entrance begins in either Fall or Spring.

Plan B

- They will complete Fifty (50) semester units or Seventy-Five (75) quarter units (or more), including specific courses for certain majors, before the end of the term prior to attending. Entrance begins in either Fall or Spring.

Please note, the maximum number of transferable units accepted, by Pacific, from a two-year school is seventy (70) semester units or one hundred and five (105) quarter units.

How Do You Arrange for a TAA?

TAA's are available from our website for the fall and spring terms: www.pacific.edu/transfer or at go.pacific.edu/taa. Once your community college counselor determines that you are eligible to transfer to The University of the Pacific and that you meet the TAA criteria for your major, he or she will begin the process.

Filing Your Application for Admission

In addition to filing a TAA you must apply to University of the Pacific by submitting a completed Undergraduate Transfer Application for admission by the transfer application deadline of the term for which you are applying. This can be found free online at www.pacific.edu/transfer by the transfer application deadline of the term for which you are applying: February 15th for Fall entrance or November 15th for Spring entrance.

A completed Undergraduate Transfer Application includes:

- Completed Transfer Application for Admission
- Official transcripts from all institutions you have attended.
- Academic Letter of Recommendation
- Personal Statement
