

Art Minor Advising Form (DRAFT 1 September 1, 2003)

- A *Minor in Art* can be achieved by completing (20 Units) of study. This includes six courses combined from the studio art and art history curriculum. A Minor Degree at Pacific includes a *Foundations Survey* (11 units) and a discipline-specific *Concentration* (9 units). A minimum of 12 units must be completed at Pacific.
- The Department encourages students to select a concentration path to bring focus and depth to their study. An exploratory path is available for students wishing to explore art broadly.
- Foundations courses should be taken with level one courses in each concentration path.
- A Minor is recorded on your official transcript. Pursuing a Minor in Art requires consultation with Major and Minor Faculty Advisors, a signature from the Department Chair and filing a Minor Degree Form with the College Dean's Office by the due dates listed on the University calendar. These dates are also listed on the Minor Form.
