Restrictions on Units Counted Toward Degree Requirement								
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must have a total of 53 Non-Art Units. No more than 83 Art units will count toward a degree. Thirty-two of the last forty units must be taken at Pacific. Units earned in AMA 1, AMA 3, and FSC 15 do not count toward a degree. Of the units required for graduation, no more than 20 units in any combination may be in: -cooperative education (92/192) -internships (87/187) -practicum (89-189) - physical education activity (ASP11) – inter-collegiate athletics (ASP 13) - dance activity (ADR 13) *of these twenty units, no more than 8 may be in activity classes ASP 11, Asp 13 ADR 13, and no more than 4 inter-collegiate athletics ASP 13. No more than 8 units of UOP extension Credit will count toward a degree. No more than two units of UOP extension credit may be earned in any one semester. 								
Limitations on General Education								
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No more than two courses from a single COP Department may counts in Categories I,II, III. No more than two courses from another UOP school may count in Categories I, II, III. No more than three courses from a single COP dept. or other UOP school may count in the whole program. Units earned by Advanced Placement examinations or independent study may not count in General Education. Only one course with a grade of "pass" may count in each of the Categories. Students with questions regarding the acceptance of a course from another college or university should consult the Associate Dean of COP.
